DALLAS — If Saturday is any indication, it could be a pretty successful track season for the Waco High boys' track team.

The Lions claimed the Class 5A team title at the Jesuit-Sheaner Relays, a prestigious meet that draws teams from Oklahoma, Arkansas as well as throughout Texas. Waco High scored 97 points to win the title going away, while Fort Worth Boswell was second with 56.5.

Lions senior Wil London, a Baylor track signee, won the 400-meter title and anchored the 4x400 team to a silver medal with a 46.4-second split. Also running on that team were Travion Johnson, Tyrone Stewart and Jonathan Hair. Waco High clocked in at 3:22.68, a time which the Lions didn't run until after the district meet last year.

Louis Davis sprinted to a gold medal in the 100 and a silver in the 200. The Lions also had bronze-medal showings from Danny Tucker in the pole vault and Jonathan Smith in the 100.
