ENTRIES: The entry fee will be \$175.00 per team or \$20.00 per individual, if **paid by March 25<sup>th</sup> (\$200/\$25 if paid after March 25<sup>th</sup>)**. Team fees will include a hat and lunch for Coaches. Please make checks payable to Jesuit Athletics. This meet has two divisions, 6A and 5A and under, Varsity only. **Entries must be submitted online at** <u>tx.milesplit.com</u>. Contestants will be seeded according to times submitted. Contestants are limited to 3 running events and 5 total events.

Changes to your original entry form must be changed online at  $\underline{tx.milesplit.com}$  & will be accepted until 3:00pm, Thursday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. After that time, no other additions will be allowed. Scratches only at the Morning meeting

- <u>AWARDS</u>: Medals for first, second and third place finishers in all events. Batons for relay winners. Trophies for High Point Man in each division and Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> Place Team in each Division. Field Event awards will be available in the official's tent south of concession stand. Track awards will be available at awards table on the Plaza at the Northwest corner of the track after conclusion of each event.
- <u>RULES</u>: The meet will be governed by the National Federation of High School Associations rules.

High Jump starting height will be 5'8" and will rise in 2" increments to 6'4". Above 6'4" the bar will be raised in 1" increments.

Long and Triple Jump contestants will be allowed 3 jumps in the preliminary round. Eight finalists will be allowed 3 additional jumps in the final round. Minimum qualifying standards are 18'0 for Long Jump and 38'0 for Triple Jump. Jumps below the qualifying standard will not be measured.

Pole Vault starting height will be 12' and will rise in 6" increments to 13'6". First Session will begin at 9:30 AM and stop after 13'6. The second session will start at 14'0" at 11:00 AM. 4A and 5A run together. Vaulters entering at the beginning of session II will be given a 40-minute warm-up period. 4A and 5A divisions jump together

Shot Put and Discus contestants will be allowed 3 throws in the preliminary round. Eight finalists will be allowed 3 additional throws in the final round. Implements will be pooled. Minimum qualifying standards are 40'0 for Shot Put and 120'0 for Discus. Throws below the qualifying standard will not be measured.

Curve judges will be present for all races. Please make sure that your athletes understand the rules prior to racing.

Official timing will be fully automatic as times and places will be determined from the Finish Lynx System. The meet director will make all logistic decisions regarding placement of starting and finish lines, runway direction, and timing systems.

**800m, 1600m, 3200m, 4x400** and **DMR** races; 5A and 6A Divisions will be combined and seeded by time. Points and medals will be awarded in finish order by Division. The 3200m will be run Friday night. The 1600m will be run in two sections on Saturday with Section 1 in the morning following the 200m preliminaries and Section 2 during the afternoon finals.

Audible tape decks and radios will not be permitted in the stands, warm-up or competition areas.

## COACHESThere will be a Coaches meeting at 7:30, please have at least one coach there to representMEETINGyour school.

- TEAMTeam camps can be set up in the Home (West side) Stands, no Tents are allowed on turfed areas orCAMPSin the Stands.
- WARM-UP Warm up will be on the Lower field, NO Athletes & coaches will be on the infield. The track will be open from 7:00 until 8:25 and 1:30 until 2:00 for Relays teams to work on exchanges and marks.
- HEATINGThe heating clerk & benches will be outside the Southeast corner of the track near the baseballCLERKstadium, the group will be walked to the starting line.

# RELAYAll members of relays teams must be checked in and will be walked to their exchange Zones.TEAMS:
